We mourn the passing of Rev. Magness P. Lutness

Rev. Lutness was born January 7, 1921 and died January 28, 2008 at a Bismarck Hospital. He enjoyed a long career having served in the military service of his country and then as a Lutheran Pastor at various locations retiring in Bismarck with his wife Viona of 64 years. He helped arrange the move of Bethel Lutheran Church to Buckstop Junction and performed the first wedding held there. Sympathy is extended to Mrs. Lutness and the family of Rev. Magness Lutness. He was a positive force in this community.

We extend sympathy to Board Member Vonnie Ereth and the rest of the family of Violet Olin. Mrs. Olin was the mother of Vonnie. Violet died at the Ereth home on February 5, 2008. Alden spent many hours and years operating the Blacksmith Shop at Driscoll which is now situated at Buckstop Junction.
